About the Opportunity

The primary function of this position is to provide high quality services including assessment, examination, and treatment and case management, along with contributing to the development of models of holistic health incorporating continuity of care.

The Aboriginal health worker works within a clinical team environment with the aim of improving the health status of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people through the provision of comprehensive and culturally valid primary health care services.

Key Selection Criteria

To be considered for this role you must have the following;

- Understanding of and Commitment to the Aboriginal community
- Demonstrated ability to provide follow-up care services for clients and families who are identified as being at risk and / or have a chronic condition
- Sound knowledge of health issues which influence the wellbeing of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and a strong commitment to improving health and wellbeing outcomes
- Self-motivated with capacity to manage own workload with limited supervision
- Demonstrated competence in use of Business Technology, internet and desktop applications
- Highly developed and effective verbal and written communication skills

Essential Selection Criteria

- Identifies as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- Provisionally registered, with AHPRA; Allied Mental Health professional; or equivalent
- Demonstrated knowledge of case management
- Demonstrated knowledge of treatment models
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- A motivated problem solver who is organised and is able to think on their feet and remain calm under pressure
- Team Player

- Knowledge of local Mental Health issues in Indigenous people
